EMBO Member Keynote Lectures

EMBO Member Keynote Lectures are given by an [EMBO Member or Associate Member](#) at a major **international scientific meeting**.

Up to 1,000 euros (within the same continent) and 2,000 euros (intercontinental, including Israel) to cover travel and accommodation costs which will be reimbursed to the speaker.

[Applications](#) are accepted throughout the year.

EMBO Young Investigator Lectures

Young Investigator Lectures are given by an eligible [EMBO Young Investigator](#) at a **scientific meeting**.

Up to 800 euros (Europe) or 1,200 euros (international) to cover travel and accommodation costs will be reimbursed to the speaker. Several Young Investigator Lectures may be funded per meeting.

[Applications](#) are accepted throughout the year.

EMBO Global Investigator Lectures

Global Investigator Lectures are given by an eligible [EMBO Global Investigator](#) at a **scientific meeting**.

Up to 800 euros (same region) or 1,800 euros (intercontinental) to cover travel and accommodation costs will be reimbursed to the speaker. Several Global Investigator Lectures may be funded per meeting.

[Applications](#) are accepted throughout the year.

Global Lecture Series

EMBO Global Lecture Series enhance collaboration between scientists worldwide. The **series of lectures** are given at institutions outside Europe by [EMBO Members or Young Investigators](#), or by leading researchers from outside Europe who visit European institutions. Priority is given to lecture series involving researchers from [EMBC Associate Member States or co-operation partners](#). [Applications](#) are accepted throughout the year.

Policy Lectures

EMBO Policy has funds to offer organizers of a scientific event the opportunity to include a non-scientific talk **addressing policy issues of science and technology**, including discussions about ethics, economics, politics, and law. Moreover, talks on policy issues related to the research system, such as the assessment of researchers and open science, can be supported. [Applications](#) are accepted throughout the year.

Women in Science Lectures

Women in Science Lectures **address issues related to gender and diversity in science**. They are **given at scientific meetings funded by EMBO**. Organizers of conferences funded through the EMBO Courses & Workshop Programme wishing to invite a scientist to speak about gender and diversity issues are encouraged to apply for this lecture grant. Expenses can be reimbursed up to 800 euros (for European speakers) and 1,200 euros (for overseas speakers) to cover travel and accommodation costs.
